Contract B – CDBG generally consists of 4,452 linear feet of 8-inch ductile iron pipe, installation 2,868 linear feet of Owner-supplied 6-inch ductile iron pipe water line along Big Creek Road, 2,227 linear feet of 2-inch PVC along Messer Branch and Tanglewood Way, and all associated appurtenances in accordance with the project plans and specifications.

All bidders must be licensed General Contractors as required by the Contractor's Licensing Act of 1994 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, and qualified for the type of construction being bid upon. The Bidder's name, license number, expiration date, and that part of the contracting classification applying to the Bid shall appear on the sealed envelope containing the Bid; otherwise, the Bid shall not be opened.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract, Section 3, Segregated Facility, Section 109 and E.O. 11246.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
