

## Camping Rates

Camping rates are listed below and State and local sales taxes will be added to the listed rates where applicable. The following camping rates will apply at all parks.

*Occupancy limits for campsites are determined by the Park. Exceptions to limits can be approved by Park Manager at the additional rate of \$1.00 per person. No Charge for children 7 years of age and under.*

**\*TN State Employee discounts:** Includes Current and Retired State Employees, and Active Duty Military

**\*\*TN Veterans Discounts:**

Veterans receive a 50% discount on campsites during off season and a free night of camping on Veterans Day.

### **Site Category General Descriptions:**

Site designations at each park to be determined by Park Manager & Regional Manager

**Type AAA:** Premium sites with water & electric that has features that put them in high demand. Examples of premium features would be individual sewer hook-up, waterfront location, scenic vista location, etc.

**Type AA:** Standard improved sites with water, electric, may have sewer or 50 amp service but do not have the features of a premium site.

**Type A:** Standard improved sites with water and electric and usual campsite amenities.

**Type B:** Improved sites with water & electric that may be in less demand due to location or with older features and limited facilities, or, improved sites without water & electric that may be in high demand due to desirable features and location.

**Type C:** Improved sites without water and electric. This can also be used for unimproved low demand, overflow sites with water & electric.

**Primitive:** Unimproved sites without water & electric to be used by tent campers only. Sites minimally developed, may have table & fire ring but little else.

**Group camping sites:** Those sites designed to accommodate larger groups of campers within a specific single location.

## **CAMPGROUND RESERVATIONS**

A flat \$5.00 non-refundable reservation fee will be charged for every (each) advanced reservation for every (each) campsite reserved at all parks whether reserved separately or simultaneously within the same reservation. An advanced reservation is considered to be any reservation made prior to the time a camper arrives on the park ready to camp. Advance reservations may be made online from up to one year in advance to as little as one day in advance of arrival, but may not be made on the day of arrival online. A single reservation may include up to 5 sites. Same day arrivals will pay for their entire stay in advance but will not be charged the reservation fee if they are ready to setup camp at the point of arrival.

All advanced reservations will pay for the entire stay for all sites reserved plus the \$5.00 reservation fee at the time of the reservation.

Reservations may be cancelled up to and including **2 days prior** to the scheduled arrival date with a refund of all campground fees - minus the \$5.00 advanced reservation fee.

Cancellations made **1 day prior** to arrival date will forfeit the first night's campsite fees, taxes and the \$5.00 advanced reservation fee, per campsite.

Cancellations made the **same day** as the scheduled arrival, for reservations of two or more days, will forfeit the first two nights' rate, taxes and the \$5.00 advanced reservation fee, per campsite. If only one night was reserved, cancelling on the scheduled arrival date will forfeit all fees and taxes, per campsite.

If a camper occupies a site before checking in, that site will only be guaranteed for one night.

An additional fee of \$1.00 per person per night will be assessed for each person over the 4 person limit for a campsite.

If the customer uses a discount, proof of eligibility for that discount must be given upon check in /arrival or the full price will be charged upon arrival for the entire stay.

## **SPECIAL CAMPING RATE FOR NONPROFIT GROUPS**

Park Manager may waive camping fee for nonprofit groups who use specified camping areas and provide sufficient volunteer labor on special park projects. Otherwise, nonprofit groups are charged 50 cents per person to camp in designated areas.

**TRANSIENT DUMP FEE:** \$5.00 per vehicle.

### **MAXIMUM CONSECUTIVE STAY:**

Maximum consecutive stay from March 1 through November 30 in any campsite is 14 nights. Off season maximum stay is 28 nights. Individuals may be requested to leave a section of the camping area or the campground after two weeks if demand dictates (*Park Manager's discretion*).
