- *Update on PCMH and Health Homes Technical Advisory Groups*
 - Due to a delay in our procurement for Primary Care Transformation consultant services, we are delaying the call for nominations for experts to advise on the design of Tennessee’s multi-payer Patient Centered Medical Homes and Health Homes for TennCare members with severe and persistent mental illness.

Updates on the Tennessee Health Care Innovation Initiative

- *Wave 1 and wave 2 episode of care reports*
 - Each TennCare MCO plans to release reports for wave 1 and wave 2 in May of this year.
 - We will notify the Provider Stakeholder Group when these reports are distributed so you can pass along to your members.

- *Reviewing wave 1 episode of care designs*
 - We are beginning to plan for our feedback session for providers and other interested stakeholders to offer suggestions on how to improve the wave 1 episode of care designs, including perinatal, acute asthma exacerbation, and total joint replacement. These sessions will be in-person, but we plan to offer phone capabilities to those unable to travel to Nashville.
 - We anticipate the meeting will be scheduled for mid to late June. Details on meeting format, date and location will be forthcoming in the next few weeks.
