

POLICY STATEMENT

POLICY REGARDING APPLICANTS WITH CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS

Applicants whose application or Criminal Background Check reveals a single misdemeanor conviction need not appear before the Board if more than five (5) years have elapsed between the date of the conviction and the date of application.

Applicants **MUST** appear before the Board, however, if their application or Criminal Background Check reveals any of the following: (1) more than one misdemeanor conviction, regardless of the date; (2) a misdemeanor conviction that occurred less than five years prior to the date of application; or (3) a felony conviction, regardless of the date.
