

Stage 2 Public Health Reporting Measure 3

Objective: The EP is in active engagement with a public health agency to submit electronic public health data from CEHRT except where prohibited and in accordance with applicable law and practice.

Measure: The EP is in active engagement to submit data to a specialized registry.

Exclusions: Any EP who meets at least 1 of the following criteria may be excluded from this measure.

1. The EP does not diagnose or treat any disease or condition associated with or collect relevant data that is required by a specialized registry in their jurisdiction during the EHR reporting period;
2. The EP operates in a jurisdiction for which no specialized registry is capable of accepting electronic registry transactions in the specific standards required by CEHRT at the beginning of their EHR reporting period;
3. The EP operates in a jurisdiction where no specialized registry *for which the EP is eligible* has declared readiness to receive electronic transactions at the beginning of their EHR reporting period.

Alternate Exclusion: Any EP may claim an alternate exclusion for measure 3 (specialized registry reporting) for an EHR reporting period in 2016.

TennCare Notes –

This objective and measure do not correspond with any criterion of Stage 1 Meaningful Use. Visit the Tennessee Department of Health (TDH) Meaningful Use [web pages](#) to find current information on their readiness to accept specialized registry electronic case reports. During 2016, the only specialized registry offered by TDH is the Cancer Registry. EPs that belong to specialty societies should check with that organization to see if they offer any specialized registries that would satisfy this measure. Acceptable specialized registries will state on their website that they satisfy EHR meaningful use requirements for specialized registries and they

Type: task to be performed

Duration: during EHR reporting period or each payment year

will require the use of the providers' certified EHR technology to submit electronic data. While this measure can only be excluded once, if an EP cannot meet any other public health options, the EP can report on 2 specialized registries to which they send electronic transactions.
