Basic Police School

The Basic Police School is the mainstay of the Tennessee Law Enforcement Training Academy. Our mission is to produce a physically fit, highly motivated, basically trained police officer thoroughly indoctrinated in the ethics and professional standards of the law enforcement profession. The officer will have a degree of both technical and tactical proficiency to function on the streets as well as in the criminal and civil courts of our state. **Orientation day for this basic class is October 2nd at 1300 hours. Attendance is mandatory.**

P.O.S.T. Rules Workshop (Bartlett PD)

Patrol & Officer Survival Tactics

Instructor: Kubic

This 32-hour block of instruction is intended for the officer that is currently assigned to a patrol division. Officers should come prepared for a classroom as well as a practical exercise course of instruction. Subjects taught will include: High Risk Call Response; Traffic Stops Procedures (high risk and unknown); Building Searches and Room Clearing; Defensive Tactics; Advanced Firearms Training; Survival Mindset and the Effects of Survival Stress on an Officer During High Risk Operations. Officers should bring their gun belt as well as clothing suitable for physical exertion to include a protective cup and mouthpiece. Officers should also bring 500 rounds of duty ammunition. Registration is through TLETA, Linda Spears (linda.spears@tn.gov) (615) 741-4448. **Maximum class size is 20 officers.**

This school will cover such topics as ethics, many areas of legal instruction, interview and interrogation, employment and administrative law and issues surrounding electronic recording and surveillance.
