

WBL: Career Practicum Course Code Updates Frequently Asked Questions

As of the start of the 2023-24 school year, there is a new structure for scheduling students enrolled in Work-Based Learning (WBL): Career Practicum courses. The following FAQs are designed to help Local Education Agencies (LEAs) navigate the new structure and ensure student enrollment is documented appropriately.

1. What is the new structure for students enrolled in WBL: Career Practicum courses?

The department has retired the course code for WBL: Career Practicum, C25H16. The previous course code has been replaced in the Course Code Management System with a set of new WBL: Career Practicum course codes that align with each career and technical education (CTE) program of study and a General WBL: Career Practicum course code for non-CTE students participating in WBL experiences.

2. Why were these new course codes created in the Course Code Management System?

The purpose of the new course codes is to align CTE concentrators' enrollment in a WBL course with the year and level of funding corresponding with their CTE program of study coursework. Under the new funding formula, the retired course code C25H16 would have defaulted to a year one, level one funded course; whereas the new course codes will receive year four funding, which truly reflects the level of rigor associated with high-quality WBL experiences.

3. Has anything changed about the implementation of a high-quality WBL: Career Practicum experience for students?

WBL: Career Practicum course standards, best practices, and course requirements have not changed. Students will continue to pursue placements that align with their program of study and career goals. WBL coordinators, administrators, and employer partners will continue providing high-quality curriculum and employment experiences in a work setting. Educators who hold any secondary teaching endorsement and an active WBL certificate are permitted to be the teacher of record for any of the new WBL: Career Practicum courses.

However, the course names and codes reflected in the master schedule will now directly connect to the program of study for all CTE students enrolled, while students with an area of elective focus outside of CTE will be enrolled in the General WBL: Career Practicum course code.

Other than enrolling students in different course codes for the period or block of class when students are participating in WBL experiences, nothing has changed about the implementation of a high-quality WBL: Career Practicum experience for students.

4. How will a section of WBL: Career Practicum students appear on a master schedule moving forward?

Master schedules will now include multiple course codes, course names, and rosters for each section of WBL: Career Practicum students. For example, if a WBL coordinator has four students from a Welding program of study, six students from a Structural Systems program of study, and eight students from a



Digital Arts and Design program of study in her 7th period section of WBL: Career Practicum, the master schedule will now include three separate course codes and rosters for that teacher's 7th period class as follows:

- One roster of WBL: Welding Career Practicum
- One roster of WBL: Structural Systems Career Practicum
- One roster of WBL: Digital Arts and Design Career Practicum

5. What are the new WBL: Career Practicum course names and course codes?

Below is a list of all the new WBL: Career Practicum course names and course codes. WBL students who are concentrators in a CTE program of study will be enrolled in the WBL: Career Practicum course that corresponds to their area of concentration:
