Introduction

The Tennessee Public Charter School Commission was established as an independent state entity, serving as the LEA for any public charter school it authorizes. Beginning in the 2020-2021 school year, the commission has the authority to authorize public charter schools on appeal of a local board of education's decision. Allocations provided to each charter schools are based on one hundred percent (100%) of state and local funds received by the LEA.

Methodology

The Tennessee Public Charter School passes through its basic education allocation to each charter school based in accordance with Tennessee Code Annotated 49-13-112, and the procedures developed by the Department of Education. Each charter schools receives their applicable state and local funding allocation funding allocation on a per pupil basis, regardless of whether they are Title I – A served; however, all schools authorized by the Commission are expected to be Title I – A served during the 2021-22 school year.
