

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications, February 19, 2009. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications were published on one of the following dates: February 17, February 18, or February 19, 2009. Public notices are generally published every two weeks. The previous publication of public notices was February 5, 2009.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, 9th Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. dba AT&T Tennessee with a mailing address of 1458 Bluebell Drive, Livermore, CA 94551. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 22-0163-01/62550) for an Emergency Generator Operation located at 5090 Hwy. 48, Cunningham, TN 37051. This existing operation consists of one (1) diesel-fired generator used to provide back-up power when electric power from the local utility is not available. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Elizabeth Peeler is the assigned Division person.

For the Dickson County *Dickson Herald* – published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is Caterpillar Inc. – Dyersburg Facility with a mailing address of 200 Hoff Road, Dyersburg, TN 38024. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 23-0109-01/62480) for a Surface Coating Operation located at 200 Hoff Road, Dyersburg, TN. This proposed operation would consist of a new spray booth with a natural gas fired curing oven. Electrostatic air atomized spray guns and exhaust filters would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. M. Ahmed is the assigned Division person.

For the Dyer County *State Gazette* -- published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is Cremation Services of East Tennessee, LLC with a mailing address of 4035 Fish Hatchery Road, Mohawk, TN 37810. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits for air contaminant sources located at the same address, as follows:

(1) Human Crematory (Division identification number: 30-0243-01/62636). This proposed operation would consist of a liquid propane incinerator and associated equipment used to cremate deceased human remains. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of air pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. J. Martin is the assigned Division person.

(2) Animal Crematory (Division identification number: 30-0243-02/62637). This proposed operation would consist of a liquid propane incinerator and associated equipment used to cremate deceased animal remains. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of air pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. J. Martin is the assigned Division person.

For the Greene County *Greeneville Sun* -- published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is InSyte Solutions, Inc. with a mailing address of 100 Hannon Drive, Lawrenceburg, TN 38464. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits for air contaminant sources located at the same address, as follows:

- (1) Natural Gas-fired Water Heater (Division identification number: 50-0005-74/62396): This existing operation consists of a 10 MMBtu/hr natural gas-fired water heater. This process was previously permitted for Swisher Mower and Machine Company, Inc. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of air pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Sarosh Kaiser is the assigned Division person.
- (2) Burn-off Oven (Division identification number: 50-0005-65/62397): This existing operation consists of a 10 MMBtu/hr natural gas-fired paint burn off oven used to remove accumulated paint from hooks used in painting operations. This process was previously permitted for Swisher Mower and Machine Company, Inc. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of air pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Sarosh Kaiser is the assigned Division person.

For the Lawrence County *Democrat-Union* --published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is PSC Industries, Inc. with a mailing address of 1100 W. Market Street, Louisville, KY 40203. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 60-0164-02/62429) for modification of a Surface Coating Operation at 2101 Oakland Parkway, Columbia, TN 38401. This existing operation consists of a spray booth and associated equipment used to coat fiberglass or foam parts. The requested modification is for recalculation of the emissions due to reduction of the coating operation and a change to a low VOC content water based material. Exhaust filters are used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. Sarosh Kaiser is the assigned Division person.

For the Maury County *Daily Herald* -- published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. dba AT&T Tennessee with a mailing address of 1458 Bluebell Drive, Livermore, CA 94551. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 63-0269-01/62551) for an Emergency Generator Operation located at 417 Madison Street, Clarksville, TN 37040. This existing operation consists of one (1) diesel-fired generator used to provide back-up power when electric power from the local utility is not available. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Elizabeth Peeler is the assigned Division person.

For the Montgomery County *Leaf-Chronicle* – published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is Citizens Gas Utility District of Scott and Morgan Counties with a mailing address of P.O. Box 68, Deer Lodge, TN, 37726. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number 65-0052-00/62617) for modification of a Natural Gas Compressor Station located at Brewstertown Road, Sunbright, TN.

This existing operation consists of one (1) Ajax 600 hp natural gas-fired engine, one (1) Ajax 360 hp natural gas-fired engine, and two (2) Natco natural gas dehydrators. The engines are used to inject or withdraw natural gas at the Indian Creek Storage Field. The dehydrators are used to remove moisture from natural gas stream. The requested modification is to include limitations that will allow Citizens Gas to opt out of being subject to the provisions of the Title V operating permit program. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. O. Jacobsen is the assigned Division person.

For the *Morgan County News* -- published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. dba AT&T Tennessee with a mailing address of 1458 Bluebell Drive, Livermore, CA 94551. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 72-0135-01/62552) for an Emergency Generator Operation located at 184 Piccadilly Avenue, Spring City, TN 37381. This existing operation consists of one (1) diesel-fired generator used to provide back-up power when electric power from the local utility is not available. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Elizabeth Peeler is the assigned Division person.

For the Rhea County *Herald-News* – published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is Lewis Brothers Bakeries, Inc. of Tennessee with a mailing address of 855 West College Street, Suite 120, Murfreesboro, TN 37120. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits (Division identification numbers: 75-0384-01/62321 and 75-0384-02/62322) to increase the facility-wide allowable emission limits for Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC). The facility is located at 847 Scott Street, Murfreesboro, TN 37120. They have also asked for a modification in the calculation used to determine VOC emissions. The company has applied for federally enforceable limits on volatile organic compound emissions from this facility in order to stay below major source permit thresholds. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air pollutants are emitted by this source. Mr. S. Kusumanchi is the assigned Division person.

For the Rutherford County *Daily News Journal* -- published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is King College, Inc. with a mailing address of 1350 King College Road, Bristol, Tennessee 37620. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 82-0185-05/62611) for eleven natural gas fired boilers located at the same address. These existing boilers are used for heating water to reheat the air in the HVAC. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use or air pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would not be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

For the Sullivan County *Bristol Herald-Courier* -- published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. dba AT&T Tennessee with a mailing address of 1458 Bluebell Drive, Livermore, CA 94551. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 94-0318-01/62548) for an Emergency Generator Operation located at 402 Franklin Road, Brentwood, TN 37027. This existing operation consists of four (4) diesel-fired generators, with four (4) aboveground and three (3) underground diesel storage tanks, used to provide back-up power when electric power from the local utility is not available. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Elizabeth Peeler is the assigned Division person.

For the Williamson County *Williamson A.M.* -- published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is Horsehead Corporation with a mailing address of P.O. Box 5, Rockwood, TN 37854. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits for sources located on 550 Clymersville Road, Rockwood, TN 37854, as follows:

(1) Indoor material handling (Division identification number: 73-0107-01/62523): There would be no physical construction. The requested modification is to increase the emission limits for the above operation. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. A baghouse is used to control particulate emissions from this source. Ms. S. Shajikumar is the assigned Division person.

(2) Coal and coke outdoor handling (Division identification number: 73-0107-02/62585): There would be no physical construction. The requested modification is to increase the emission limits for the above operation. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. Ms. S. Shajikumar is the assigned Division person.

(3) Conveying and loading operation (Division identification number: 73-0107-05/62586): There would be no physical construction. The requested modification is to increase the emission limits for the above operation. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. A baghouse is used to control particulate emissions from this source. Ms. S. Shajikumar is the assigned Division person.

(4) Pneumatic railcar unloading (Division identification number: 73-0107-09/62587): There would be no physical construction. The requested modification is to change the installation description for the above operation. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. Ms. S. Shajikumar is the assigned Division person.

For the *Roane County News* -- published once on or before Thursday, February 19, 2009.

The applicant is BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. dba AT&T Tennessee with a mailing address of 1458 Bluebell Drive, Livermore, CA 94551. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 95-0307-01/62553) for an Emergency Generator Operation located at 230 West Gay St., Lebanon, TN 37087. This existing operation consists of one (1) diesel-fired generator used to provide back-up power when electric power from the local utility is not available. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Elizabeth Peeler is the assigned Division person.
