Have you ever seen our national symbol, the Bald Eagle? If not, come to Reelfoot Lake State Park this winter and take one of our tours?

Van tours to observe Bald Eagles and Waterfowl will be conducted seven days a week from January 2nd through early March by state park personnel. All tours will depart from Reelfoot Lake State Park Visitor Center. **TOUR RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED AND THERE WILL BE A MODERATE CHARGE PER PERSON (\$5.00 Each)**

Special groups (school, scout, clubs, etc.) should make reservations two to three weeks in advance. Groups should also consider providing their own transportation. All tours will involve some exposure to the elements, so please dress warmly. Bring your field glasses and cameras for added enjoyment.

Special weekend programs will be conducted each weekend in January and February. See below a listing of our weekend activities.

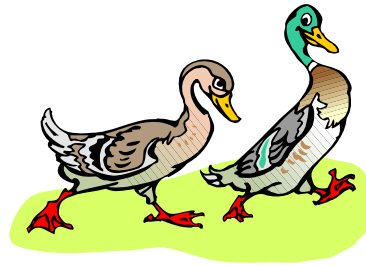
WEEKDAYS (M-F) 10:00AM Two hour Bald Eagle & Waterfowl Tour departs from the Visitor Center.

SATURDAYS 7:30AM, 10:00AM & 1:30PM - Two hour Bald Eagle & Waterfowl Tour departs from the Visitor Center.

SUNDAYS 10:00 AM & 1:30 PM: - Two hour Bald Eagle & Waterfowl Tour departs from the Visitor Center.

SATURDAYS 7:00 PM – Join park Naturalist at the Visitor Center for a power point presentation on the history of Reelfoot Lake followed by a live Bird Of Prey program.

SATURDAY & SUNDAY AFTERNOONS: Special Wildlife Programs will be offered in the Visitor Center.



MOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS – Reelfoot Lake State Park has a five unit mini motel. Mailing address is 2595 Hwy 21E, Tiptonville, Tennessee 38079. Phone (731-253-9652). **NOTE: THE SPILLWAY ROOMS WILL BE CLOSED FOR CHRISTMAS HOLIDAY PERIOD.** Senior Citizen providing proof of age 62 years or older will receive a 10% discount on lodging. Microwave ovens, coffee pots, and refrigerators are provided in each room. There are many fine restaurants and motels located on the south end of Reelfoot Lake.

CAMPING - Reelfoot Lake State Park operates two campgrounds, one is adjacent to the Airpark Inn, the other is located approximately 15 miles south. No reservations for camping will be accepted, first-come, first-served. Airpark campsites have electric and water hookups. The southern campground is closed during winter months, but the Airpark Campground is open seven days a week, year round.
