

NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPROVE A CLOSURE PLAN FOR A HAZARDOUS
WASTE MANAGEMENT UNIT

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation's (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) proposes to approve the closure plan at Selective Structures, LLC, 811 East Avenue, Athens, McMinn County, TN 37303 (located 0.3 miles south of the intersection of US Hwy 11 and TN Route 305). EPA ID Number TND 98 211 4761.

Selective Structures constructs billboard towers and in the process generates hazardous paint/solvent and paint/solvent-contaminated wastes. During an inspection, DSWM discovered two areas at the facility where waste paint solvent was disposed of in sawdust. Selective Structures containerized the sawdust piles and shipped the waste offsite to an approved hazardous waste treatment facility. DSWM required Selective Structures to submit a closure plan that included soil sampling to confirm the adequacy of the remediation. Selective Structures sampled the soil for xylene, methyl ethyl ketone, and toluene.

The analytical results from the soil sampling were submitted to DSWM in the Confirmatory Sampling Results Report dated March 17, 2009. The results indicated that all constituents of concern were either not detected or below the EPA Regional Screening Levels for Residential Soil. DSWM determined that Selective Structures has completed closure by removing the waste and contaminated soil and does not intend to require additional investigation or removal.
