

STATE RELEASES NEW GEOLOGICAL REPORT

A new bulletin is available from the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, Division of Geology. *Tennessee Topography* is No. 86 in a series.

“This publication presents the results of a study of the topography found in the three Grand Divisions of Tennessee,” says author David D. Starnes. “Topographic information provided for each of the 95 counties in these three state divisions includes area data; high and low elevations; elevations of cities, towns, and rural communities; major topographic features; and a general description of the county’s topography.”

David Starnes is Principal Planner in the Upper Cumberland Section of the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development’s Local planning Assistance Office in Cookeville, Tennessee.

According to State Geologist Ron Zurawski, “In addition to a detailed discussion of each county’s topography and water features, this book includes a summary of Tennessee’s physiographic provinces, general geology, and drainage basins, plus a brief discussion of topographic maps.”

Also included are topographic indexes for each county; measurements of land and water area and physiographic provinces; a glossary; a list of suggested readings and additional resources; 64 figures, including excerpts from 25 topographic maps and 29 color photographs; plus 3 tables and 4 appendixes that summarize county area measurements, elevations, and physiographic provinces, and area measurements and physiographic provinces of selected state and federal domains; in addition to area measurements, ownership, and primary use of selected Tennessee lakes.

The book has GBC binding, and has been assigned International Standard Book Number (ISBN) 9780979617836.
