AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 29, Chapter 20, relative to governmental tort liability.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 29, Chapter 20, Part 1, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated section:

SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Any municipality, metropolitan government, county, utility district with more than 5,000 customers, school district, public hospital, or nonprofit volunteer fire department receiving funds appropriated by a county legislative body or a legislative body of a municipality, human resource agency, public building authority, or development district shall file an annual report regarding its tort liability activities with the office of the State Treasurer, for the previous fiscal year on a form prescribed by the State Treasurer. The report shall be due on March 30, 2001, and on March 30 each year thereafter for a period of three (3) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
