

## **Tennessee Department of Agriculture Food Permits/Licenses**

### **Retail Food Store Permit**

Establishment, or section of an establishment, where food and food products are offered to consumers and intended for off-premise consumption.

### **Mobile Meat License**

For the sale of farm-based meats, processed, packaged and labeled at a USDA inspected facility, and then sold as retail from mobile unit.

### **Mobile Seafood License**

Retail sales of pre-packaged seafood from an approved/inspected source, or unpackaged seafood from an approved/inspected source sold from an inspected mobile unit which meets requirements as listed.

### **Domestic Kitchen Permit**

Permit for preparing, manufacturing and selling non-potentially hazardous foods commercially from a home-based kitchen.

Also, allowing non-potentially hazardous foods produced in home-based kitchens to be sold at certain venues without requirement to be licensed or inspected.

### **Manufacturing/Warehouse Permit**

Food manufacturing, preparation, processing, packaging, and/or holding for distribution

### **Manufacturing Within**

Preparing, processing or packaging foods and holding for distribution within a separate existing establishment.
