### STEPS NECESSARY IN CONDUCTING ELECTION FOR SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT SUPERVISORS

1. County Nominating Committee to set date of election and decide on polling places and time of day polls will be open.
2. Complete the nomination form with names of candidates to be placed on ballot – at least six – more if desired.
3. A reasonable waiting period between completing the nominating form and holding the election is suggested to allow other persons to get their name on the ballot if they so desire.
4. Adequate notice of the election using the attached suggested format (Supervisor Elections to be Held) should be made locally through newspapers, newsletters, announcements at meetings, postings at farm supply stores and other means to insure countywide awareness. If published, two notices are recommended a week apart.
5. Select polling officers to man polling places. Must be manned during announced voting hours.
6. Conduct the election and count votes.
7. Immediately report results of election to the State Soil Conservation Committee.
