




Children and Youth Crisis Services: FY14 and FY15



How did crisis services for children and youth change?



Face to face crisis assessments increased 19% in FY15.

Frontier Health (northeast), Helen Ross McNabb (east), and Mental Health Coop (middle) served counties in dark blue in FY15. Youth Villages served all counties in FY14, and those in light blue in FY15.

10,442 face to face assessments of children and youth in crisis occurred in FY15: 1,689 more than FY14.



53% of face to face assessments occurred at emergency rooms or hospitals in FY15.



9,483 or 92% of face to face assessments occurred within 2 hours in FY15: 1,547 more than FY14.
