ORDER APPROVING WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW-ONLY FILING

This matter was presented for consideration in accordance with TENN. CODE ANN. § 50-6-402(b), which requires the Commissioner of Commerce and Insurance ("Commissioner") to consult with the Advisory Council on Workers Compensation ("Advisory Council") before approving any workers' compensation loss cost filing made by the designated rate service organization and approve, disapprove or modify the filing within ninety (90) days of receiving the filing.


On September 6, 2013, the National Council on Compensation Insurance ("NCCI") submitted its Workers Compensation Loss Costs and Rating Values Law-Only Filing for the Tennessee voluntary market ("Law-Only Filing"), which recommended a decrease of 5.9 percent in the proposed March 1, 2014 loss costs for new, renewal and outstanding policies with a proposed effective date of July 1, 2014. The Advisory Council met on October 31, 2013, to consider the Law-Only Filing and, by letter to the Commissioner dated November 1, 2013, advised that the Advisory Council agreed to concur with the NCCI recommendation of a decrease of 5.9 percent effective July 1, 2014.

The Commissioner agrees with the recommendation of the Advisory Council, provided adjustment is made to take into account the impact of modifications made by the Commissioner to the rating values of the March 1, 2014 loss cost filing. Accordingly, the Law-Only Filing

submitted by NCCI on September 6, 2013, is hereby **APPROVED** subject to the modifications made by the Commissioner to the rating values of the March 1, 2014 loss cost filing.

It is so **ORDERED**.


