Summer II includes 32 hours online (9-11am on 7/13, 9-noon & 1-3pm on 7/14, 7/15, 7/16, 7/17, 7/20, 7/21) and 8 hours face-to-face. To serve various regions, the instructor(s) will travel and replicate the face-to-face meeting in 4 cities, contingent upon minimum enrollment for each city (8-noon & 1-5pm on 7/22 in Cleveland, on 7/23 in Knoxville, on 7/24 in Nashville, on 7/25 in Memphis).
