1. What is the school report card?

The Tennessee Department of Education releases an annual report card on Tennessee schools. This report displays state, district and school-level data for each school year.

2. What information does the school report card include?

It includes information on demographics, achievement, academic growth, attendance, graduation rate and more. You can view the statewide data, or you can choose a specific district or school.

3. Why is there a state report card?

The Tennessee State Report Card allows public access to education information, informs and supports various stakeholder groups and fulfills federal requirements.
