#### **Equinox Sunrise – March 20, 2015**

The Tennessee Division of Archaeology will conduct a sunrise program atop Sauls mound on Friday, March 20 at 6:45 am. From this vantage point, the sun will rise over Mound 29, which the Native Americans built as a marker mound for the Equinox sunrises.

Participants should plan to arrive at the Pinson Museum parking lot between 6:00 and 6:30 to allow time to walk to and climb the stairs to the platform atop Sauls Mound.
