Smithsonian Artifacts Returned

A number of artifact collections were donated to the Pinson Museum upon its completion in 1980, which were utilized in the educational displays. Several artifacts within this assemblage were labeled and numbered, indicating a connection to the Smithsonian Museum in Washington, D.C. The Smithsonian was contacted and arrangements were made to return these artifacts in December of 2007. Returning these items to the Smithsonian also provided the opportunity to see Dennis Stanford's Paleoindian collection and other artifacts recovered from Tennessee. This Powerpoint presentation will provide details of these Zuni artifacts, as well as some amazing photographs from behind the scenes at one of the most spectacular museums in the United States.
