

**The Sinclair Site: A Clovis Quarry in Wayne County, Tennessee**



Avocational archaeologist Rex Moore discovered the Sinclair site – a 12,000 year old Clovis site while collecting high quality Buffalo River chert in Wayne County, Tennessee. Mr. Moore recognized the importance of the find and informed archaeologists at the Old Stone Fort Knap-In last September. A site visit revealed large blades, blade cores, bifaces, and Clovis preforms located adjacent to where the high quality chert is found eroding out of the hillside. John will describe the significance of this quarry site discovery and how it will help us locate similar sites throughout Tennessee.
