# Existing Grant Offerings

Deadline – Thursday, October 1, 2015, 4:30pm CDT.

- Recycling Equipment - \$200,000
  - Rebate counties are ineligible
- Waste Reduction - \$1,000,000
  - Rebate counties are eligible
- Used Oil Grant - \$1,500,000
  - Improvements to the grant - general contractor, storage tanks, SPCC, new convenience center infrastructure

## Rule 0400-11-01-.09 Waste Reduction and Planning

(5) (b) Class III/IV landfills shall report to the Department county of origin and tonnage of material collected and disposed annually by January 31

(5) (c) Recovered Materials Processing Facilities that manage over 100 tons per year of reclaimed, recovered or recycled materials or are publically owned shall report to the Department the county of origin and tonnage by commodity type processed by March 1 of each calendar year. Option to report quarterly.

- Initial notification has been sent and forms are being developed
- Follow up notice with forms to be sent in December
