## Purpose

The Landfill Operators Certification Training Program is designed to provide certification for Class I Landfill Operators in accordance with TCA-68-211-853. You will gain invaluable information concerning the basic skills and regulations required to operate a landfill.

## Who Should Attend

All landfill owners and operators are encouraged to attend this “state certification” program. Any other interested parties involved in landfill operations are welcome as well, including Class II, III and IV landfill operators.

## Date, Time & Location

The Landfill Operators Certification Training Program will be held at the Montgomery Bell State Park in Burns, TN, March 28 - March 31. This four-day course will begin promptly at 10 a.m. CDT on Monday, March 28<sup>th</sup> and will conclude at noon, Thursday, March 31<sup>st</sup>. Applicants needing certification must take the test on Thursday.

## Cost

The cost for the training course is \$400 per person. The cost includes tuition, course materials and the certification examination. Lunch will be provided on all the training days, but not on the day of the test. There will be two outdoor exercises. Be sure to bring appropriate attire for these exercises.

All participants are responsible for their travel reservations and expenditures, including lodging and meals. The Montgomery Bell State Park Inn will take reservations for rooms at the Inn, and/or villas. Please contact the Park Office at 615-797-3101 or toll free at 1-800-250-8613.

## Montgomery Bell State Park Burns, TN

From I-40 East from Memphis or I-40 West from Nashville: Take I-40 to Exit 182 (Fairview/Dickson Hwy. 96 Exit). Turn right (West) onto Highway 96. Stay on Highway 96 until it dead-ends at Highway 70. Turn right (East) on Highway 70, off ramp provided. Stay on Highway 70 approximately 3 miles. Park entrance is on the right.
