

BOARD OF EXAMINERS IN PSYCHOLOGY
POLICY STATEMENT
REGARDING PROOF OF EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY FOR NON-UNITED
STATES BORN APPLICANTS

The Board of Examiners in Psychology realizes that it has a duty to require its non-United States citizen applicants for licensure or certification to obtain proof of proper authorization for eligibility for employment in the United States. To the end that it requires United States citizens to provide a notarized copy of a birth certificate, the Board hereby requires non-citizens to provide to the Board, prior to eligibility, for licensure or certification as a Psychologist, Senior Psychological Examiner, Psychological Examiner or Certified Psychological Assistant, a notarized copy of the applicant's Green Card

This Policy Statement was adopted by the Board of Examiners in Psychology on the 29th of January 2009.
