

**BOARD OF EXAMINERS IN PSYCHOLOGY
POLICY STATEMENT
REGARDING CONTINUING EDUCATION IN JURISPRUDENCE AND ETHICS**

The Board of Examiners in Psychology (“The Board”) requires three (3) hours of Type I, II, or III continuing education in jurisprudence and ethics. See Rule 1180-1-.08(1)(e)1. and 2., and 3.

In order for a licensee to show proof of compliance with the jurisprudence component in Rule 1180-1-.08(1)(e)1. and 2., the individual may submit a statement that he/she has read and informally discussed the following with colleagues:

- a. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 63, Chapter 11; and
- b. Official Compilation, Rules and Regulations of the State of Tennessee, Chapters 1180-1, 1180-2, 1180-3, and 1180-4.

This statement must contain the date of completion and the names of the licensees participating in the discussion, and be signed by the licensee. It shall constitute one (1) hour of Type III continuing education.

A licensee who submits such a statement must still show proof of compliance with the ethics requirement in Rule 1180-1-.08(1)(e)3.pertaining to the American Psychological Association’s “Ethical Standards”.
