

POLICY STATEMENT

BOARD OF EXAMINERS IN PSYCHOLOGY

POLICY: EXPERT TESTIMONY

The Board of Examiners in Psychology recognizes that an individual licensed to practice psychology in another jurisdiction may want to come to Tennessee to solely provide expert testimony. In reference to solely providing expert testimony, the Board does not interpret the supervisory requirement listed in TENN. COMP. R. & REGS. 1180-02-.05(3)(f) to require clinical supervision of services performed. However, the supervisory requirement listed in TENN. COMP. R. & REGS. 1180-02-.05(3)(f) does require the out of state practitioner to obtain a licensed psychologist as a consultant in regards to the Tennessee laws related to the practice of psychology. This policy only applies to out of state practitioners who would like to come to Tennessee to solely provide expert testimony.
