**ANNOUNCEMENT: IT Manager – SR. for the Tennessee Board of Parole - Nashville**

The Tennessee Board of Parole is seeking a highly qualified and motivated individual to serve as the IT Manager- Sr. in the Board's Central Office in Nashville. This Executive Appointment position is a pay grade BPP 044 with a starting monthly salary of \$6,284, \$75,408 annually. The salary for the appointee will be dependent upon the individual's education and experience.

The Board of Parole is an independent agency of the State of Tennessee. It is composed of seven members who are appointed by the Governor. By statute, the Board has the authority to parole eligible offenders who have served a certain percentage of their sentences. It also has the authority to revoke parole privileges if offenders do not comply with supervision rules and standards set forth for them upon their release. Additionally, the Board considers requests for executive clemency and makes recommendations on those requests to the Governor.

This person will lead the Information Systems division of the Tennessee Board of Parole under the Probation/Parole Administrator for Management Resources. The position's responsibilities include managing the development of the agency's paperless parole system and other business related systems; coding application software which interfaces with other programs and systems; writing or modifying program specifications to meet agency needs for flow of data and functional processes within the program; creating test plans and executing test runs of programs to verify agency specifications are met; and verifying accuracy of program output and ease of use for agency staff.

Additionally, this position will be responsible for designing and implementing procedures for maintenance, repair, and replacement of hardware and software; evaluating new technology for agency use and detailing the impact to current business processes; determining best practices for equipment used by agency staff; and developing procedural manuals to document and train staff on systems. This position will also assist the administrator in the development of agency information systems policies along with the annual Information Systems Plan.

Applicants for this position must possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and five years of professional level information technology experience including at least two years of supervision. Graduation from an accredited college or university with an associate's degree in an information technology field may substitute for the bachelor's degree. Professional experience in information technology may substitute for the required information technology associate's degree to a maximum of two years. Additional graduate coursework in information technology may substitute for the required experience on a year for year basis to a maximum of two years.

All employees of the Board of Parole are expected to be of good moral character. A criminal history records request will be completed for any candidate receiving an offer of employment with the Board.

Pursuant to the State of Tennessee's policy of non-discrimination, the Board of Parole does not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, religion, color, national or ethnic origin, age disability, military service in its policies, or in the admission or access to, or treatment or employment in, its programs, services or activities.
