- Collaborates in a team environment to understand requirements, designs systems to meet those requirements, establishes test criteria, supports the testing process, prepares applications for implementation, and creates system documentation.
- Provides break-fix, troubleshooting, and user support for assigned systems.
- Manages time effectively to consistently deliver high-quality solutions on schedule.
- Improves knowledge and understanding of current technologies and processes and applies these to develop modern applications.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in Information Systems or Computer Science
- Minimum of 2-5 years in comparable positions including software development, database design, systems analysis, or design
- Application Development experience with object oriented programming for client-server and web-based applications using (C#, jQuery, .NET, HTML, XML, CSS, Microsoft SQL Server, and/or Oracle)
