Information has been received notifying the Tennessee Department of Labor of a Layoff at Johnson & Johnson Health Care Systems, Inc. which is effective April 4, 2016. The total number of affected workers is 127. This company is located at 3955 E. Holmes Road, Memphis, TN 38118. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor & Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on February 5, 2016.

The employees at the facility are not represented by a collective bargaining agreement. In the WARN letter the company stated that 122 of the 127 affected employees are being outsourced to another company. The local Department of Labor and Workforce Development Rapid Response team has been notified to coordinate services for the effected employees.
