I, Jim Moore, Director of Program Development and Administration, request approval to utilize the following proprietary items within the City of Pigeon Forge's control and maintenance over the next three years where Federal and/or State funding is used:

Phillips Lumec Lighting –pedestrian pole and light fixture Ancestra AT-40^{MD} -SHA-GRD-NM

Justification

Per the Code of Federal Regulations, 23 CFR 635.411, justification can be made that these items are essential for the aesthetic continuity of two previously lighted sections of the Riverwalk. The City of Pigeon Forge is aware of only one manufacturer, Phillips Lumec Lighting that has the aesthetic appearance consistent with the existing light fixtures.

Proprietary Material Approval for Phillips Lumec Lighting Pole Fixture

Dear Mr. Falkenberg:

In attempt to achieve consistency in all phases of our greenway network, the City of Pigeon Forge has used the same light pole and fixture made by Phillips Lumec on the first two phases of our greenway. Phase III connects to Phase II and will provide a continuous greenway trail from Patriot Park to the Community center and it will be critical to maintain the same light fixture on Phase III.

The pole and fixture used on Phase I and II is the Phillips Lumec Ancesta AT-40^{MD}-SHA-GRD-NM product. It is a very distinctive pole with a rounded top and a classic fixture. We know of no other manufacturer that makes a pole and fixture of the same design and character.

In consideration of the statements presented, the City of Pigeon Forge requests that the Phillips Lumec Ancesta AT-40^{MD}-SHA-GRD-NM pole and fixture be considered for use on Phase III of our greenway. In addition, we request that the same be specified for use on future state funded phases of our greenway in the City of Pigeon Forge.
