

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT
STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is seeking comments on Amendment #157 to the 2014-2017 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The new statewide Amendment #157 provides funds under a new category. The current highway act, through the FAST Act §1116; 23 U.S.C. 167, makes the National Highway Freight Program (NHFP) money available to state departments of transportation. The federal funds for Tennessee during Fiscal Year (FY) 2016 are in the amount of \$24,179,487 and TDOT has elected to match this with \$6,044,872 in state funds. For FY 2017, \$23,139,769 federal funds would be available with a \$5,784,942 state match. The NHFP funds attachment details the purposes for which these NHFP funds may be employed. Projects utilizing such funds are to be let to contract by TDOT.
