



Attestation Status

TennCare has been experiencing some technical difficulties in getting the Attestation Packets sent to providers. Our original plan was to have them out beginning April 5th. We now expect to have them out on Monday April 18th.

At present, you can go to <http://www.state.tn.us/tenncare/pipregistration.html> and tell us how you intend to attest – as an individual, as a part of a group practice, or as a hospital. You must tell us how you are going to attest before we can generate your Attestation Packet. If you have already done this, you do not need to go back and repeat the process.

⇒ **Remember**, you must have a certified EHR system or module(s) in order to attest. If you did not report your CMS Certification Number at the time you registered, you must return to the CMS registration web site and enter that number. The CMS Certification Number is **not** the number your vendor received from CCHIT, Drummond, or InfoGard, or another ONC ATCB. If you do not have your CMS Certification Number, go to <http://onc-chpl.force.com/ehrcert>, and follow the instructions. We will **not** be able to generate your Attestation Packet until you have a certified EHR system or module(s) recorded with your registration.
