

- [1] a low place between hills or mountains
- [3] the area of land beside an ocean or sea
- [5] a very high, Rocky land formation, usually with steep sides and a pointed or rounded top.
- [7] a flat or gently rolling area of land with only moderate changes in elevation
- [9] a large, long-lasting river of slow-moving ice on land
- [10] a very dry, barren region usually sand, with little or no trees and a low average yearly rainfall

- [1] a cone-shaped mountain vent in the Earth's crust that is formed as a lava, rock and ash or hot gases spew through the crater from deep inside the Earth
- [2] the seven largest masses on Earth
