


Do I need to apply for an Edison Vendor ID/Supplier ID/Edison Number?

- If you received an award from the VFEAT or Rescue Squad Grant Program in prior years – **No**
 - The Fire Marshal’s Office team can look up the supplier information, if you have questions, please contact the team. You will need to provide your department’s Employer Identification Number (EIN) Contact information
- Have you previously applied for a Edison Vendor ID/Supplier ID/Edison Number as part of your grant application, but not awarded a grant – **No**
 - The Fire Marshal’s Office team can look up the supplier information, if you have questions, please contact the team. You will need to provide your department’s Employer Identification Number (EIN) Contact information
- If your department is associated with a City or County Government – **Most likely no**, but check with the accounting or fiscal department, they likely have an existing Edison Vendor ID/Supplier ID/Edison Number.
- Has your department received any other grants from the State (examples: Agricultural, Forestry, TEMA) if so, you **likely have an existing number**.

Where can I find my Edison Vendor ID/Supplier ID/Edison Number?

Were you awarded a grant last year? If so, your Supplier ID can be found on your contract.
