
ORDER

The cause came to be heard by telephone conference call on February 12, 2009, before Lynn M. England, Administrative Judge, on a Motion for Summary Judgment filed by the Hartford, ("Hartford"). Present at the hearing was Ben M. Rose, Esq., on behalf of Hartford. The Insured, Phillip George, d/b/a/ Phillip George Painting, *pro se*, did not participate in the hearing. The parties were served with an Order issued by the undersigned on January 27, 2009, setting this matter for hearing February 12, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. Moreover, attempts to reach the Insured by telephone were unsuccessful.

Based upon the Hartford's Motion for Summary Judgment, the Insured's failure to file a response or participate in the hearing despite receiving notice of the same, arguments of counsel, the Order to Compel entered on December 2, 2008, and the record as a whole, Hartford's motion was GRANTED.

It is hereby ORDERED that judgment shall be entered against Phillip George d/b/a Phillip George Painting in the amount of \$11,667.00.<sup>1</sup> Further, the Insured's administrative appeal of Hartford's premium audit determination is hereby dismissed with prejudice, and costs of this appeal are hereby taxed against Phillip George d/b/a Phillip George Painting, for which execution may issue, if necessary.

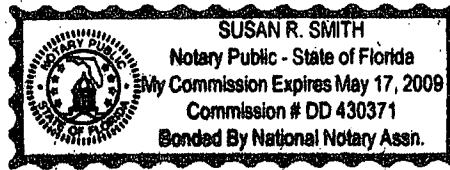
