TN Historic Development Grant Program



A Brief Overview

Enacted by the TN General Assembly in April 2021, the program funds a portion of eligible expenses for historic preservation projects across the state.

Funds up to 30% of eligible rehabilitation/restoration expenses for historic projects

Can be combined with the Federal Tax Credit which funds tup to an additional 20% of eligible expenses

Documentation and review requirements and process are similar for both the state grant and federal credit.

Fills Critical Financing Gap

Borrow less for a \$1,500,000 renovation

With up to 30% of eligible costs covered by the state grant with an additional 20% by the Federal Tax Credit, up to 50% of the eligible rehabilitation costs can be offset.

The following example shows how this can affect the long-term mortgage payments:

Example from a Florida project (National Trust data)

Monthly Mortgage	\$7,984 – no federal
Payment	HTC
Monthly Mortgage	\$6,487 – with federal
Payment	HTC
Monthly Mortgage Payment	\$4,823 – with Federal & State Historic Tax Credits



Tipton-Fillauer House Case Study

First Completed Project of the Historic Development Grant Program

63 Broad St | Cleveland TN

- Located in downtown Cleveland, Tennessee
- 132 years old, but sat empty with raining pouring in for several years
- Ben & Chris Berry, from Cleveland, own a sixperson engineering firm
- Bought the house in Spring 2021, started work in June and completed the renovation in December 2021
- Renovated space now provides room for more employees and a lawn for community events.

Eligible Grant Amount (30%)	\$62,400
