Dear Mr. Winningham,

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-3004(a) (6) In the event of a natural disaster or serious outbreaks of illness affecting or endangering students or staff during a school year, the commissioner of education may waive for that school year the requirement under subdivision (a)(1) of one hundred eighty (180) days of classroom instruction, if a request is submitted to the commissioner by the director of schools. The waiver request may be for the entire LEA or for individual schools within the LEA.

The Overton County school system has requested approval for the closure of schools on February 16 and 17, 2021 and is requesting that the use two instructional day be waived due to the ice storm that caused electricity outage and roads closed. Due to the ice storm and endangering students, the department is accepting this request to waive two instructional days for February 16 and 17, 2021.

Pursuant to my above referenced authority, I hereby grant a waiver to Overton County Schools for two instructional days for February 16 and 17, 2021. Please revise the calendar in EIS to indicate the change. Thank you for continuing to notify the Department of your needs related to your school calendar.

Therefore, OCS is equipped to deliver additional days of hybrid/remote instructional learning that would be equitable to classroom instruction. The district's CIP was formulated to ensure that students would receive equitable instruction virtually rather than making up lost instructional days.
