# Metro Nashville Public Schools must correct these violations by implementing the following corrective actions:

- 1. DCS must offer to convene an IEP meeting with Complainant to determine the need for and amount of any compensatory education services and the timeframe in which they will be provided.
- 2. DCS must submit documentation to the Department stating whether an IEP meeting occurred to determine the need for and amount of any compensatory education services and the timeframe in which they will be provided and, if so, what decisions were made at the meeting.
- 3. DCS must Provide training for all appropriate staff on the aforementioned regulations.
- 4. DCS must submit documentation of training (sign-in sheets and training materials) to the Department.
