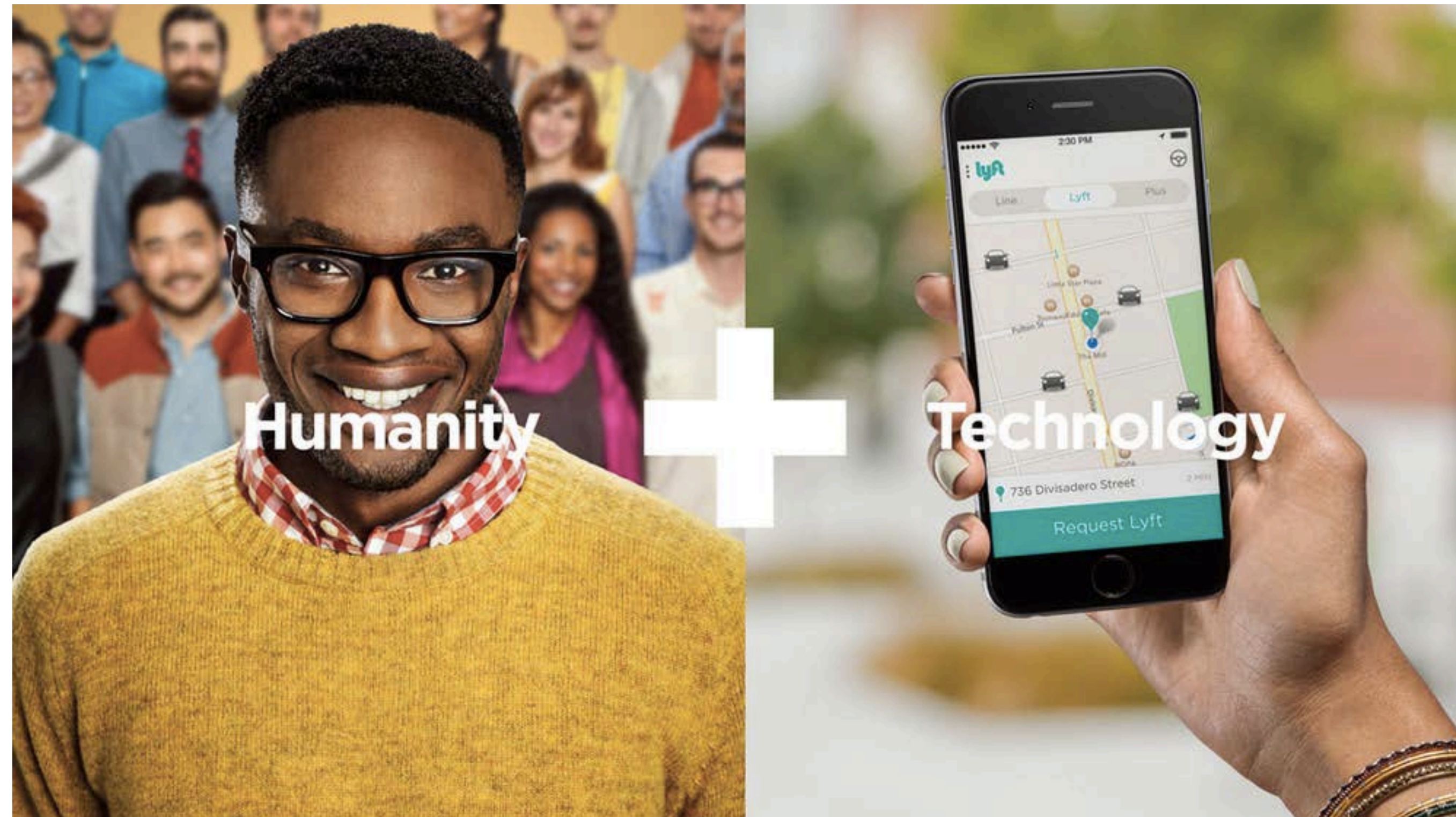

Shared rides along shared routes, priced for daily use. Available first in New York, Los Angeles, and San Francisco.



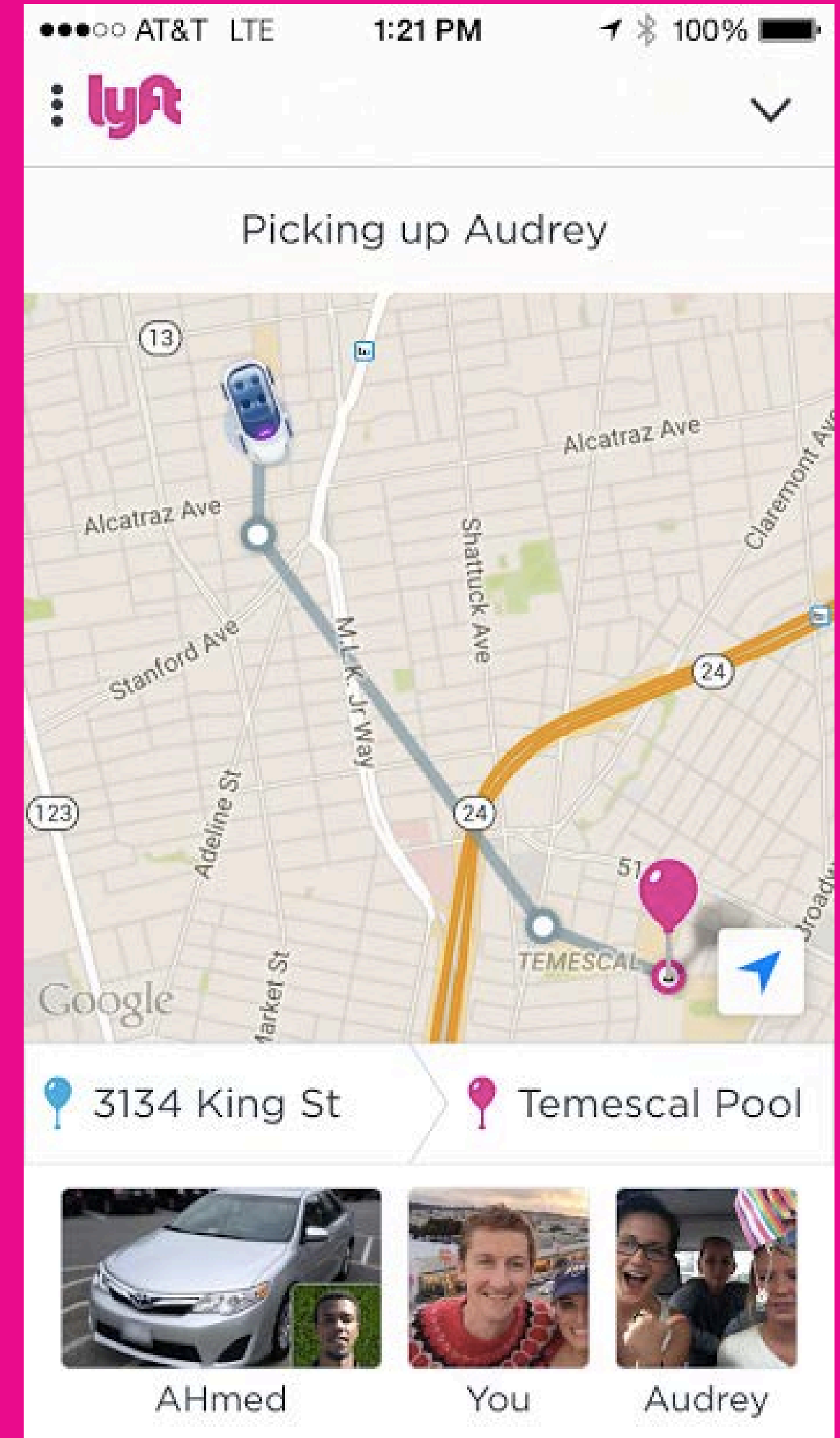
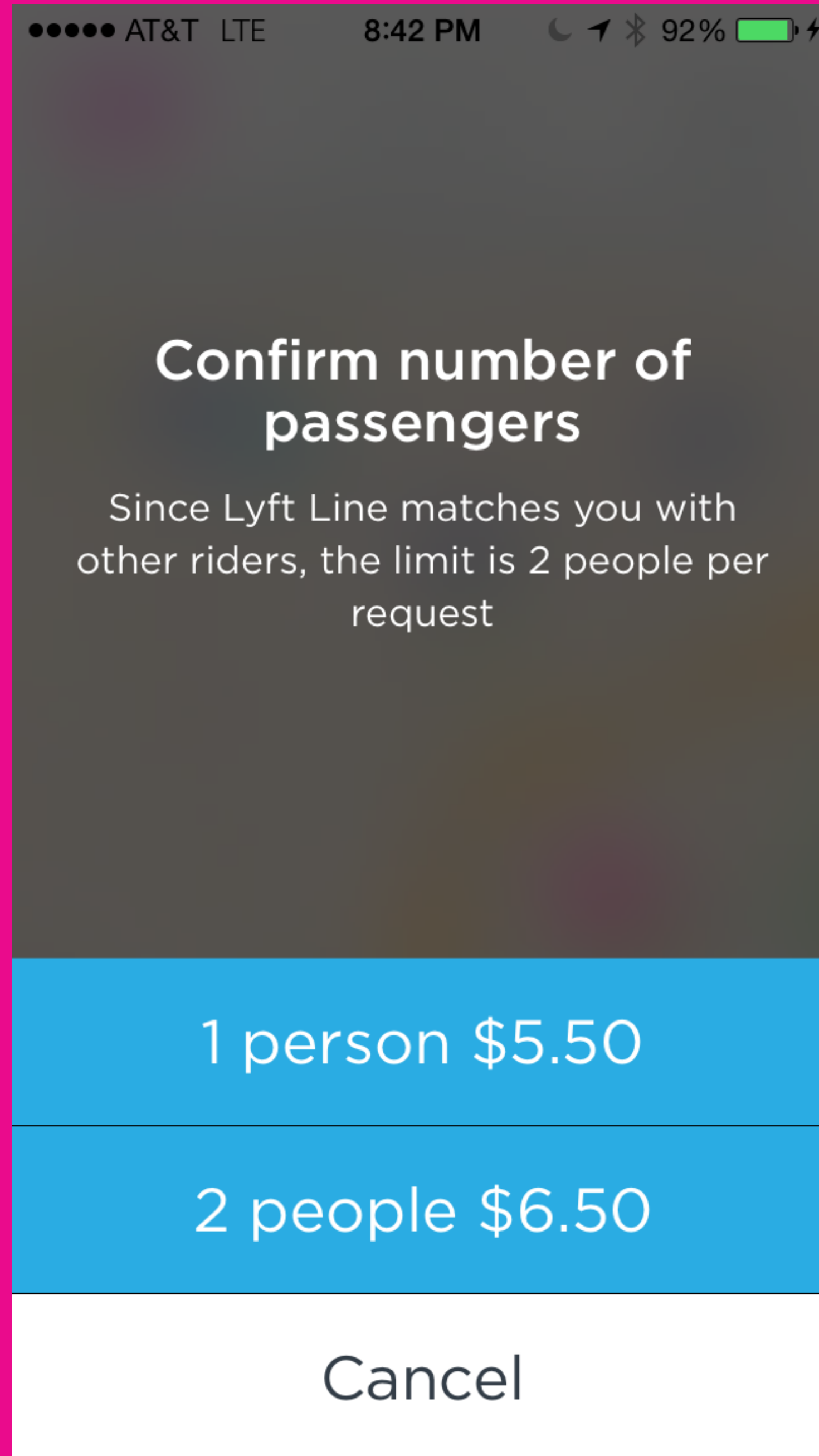
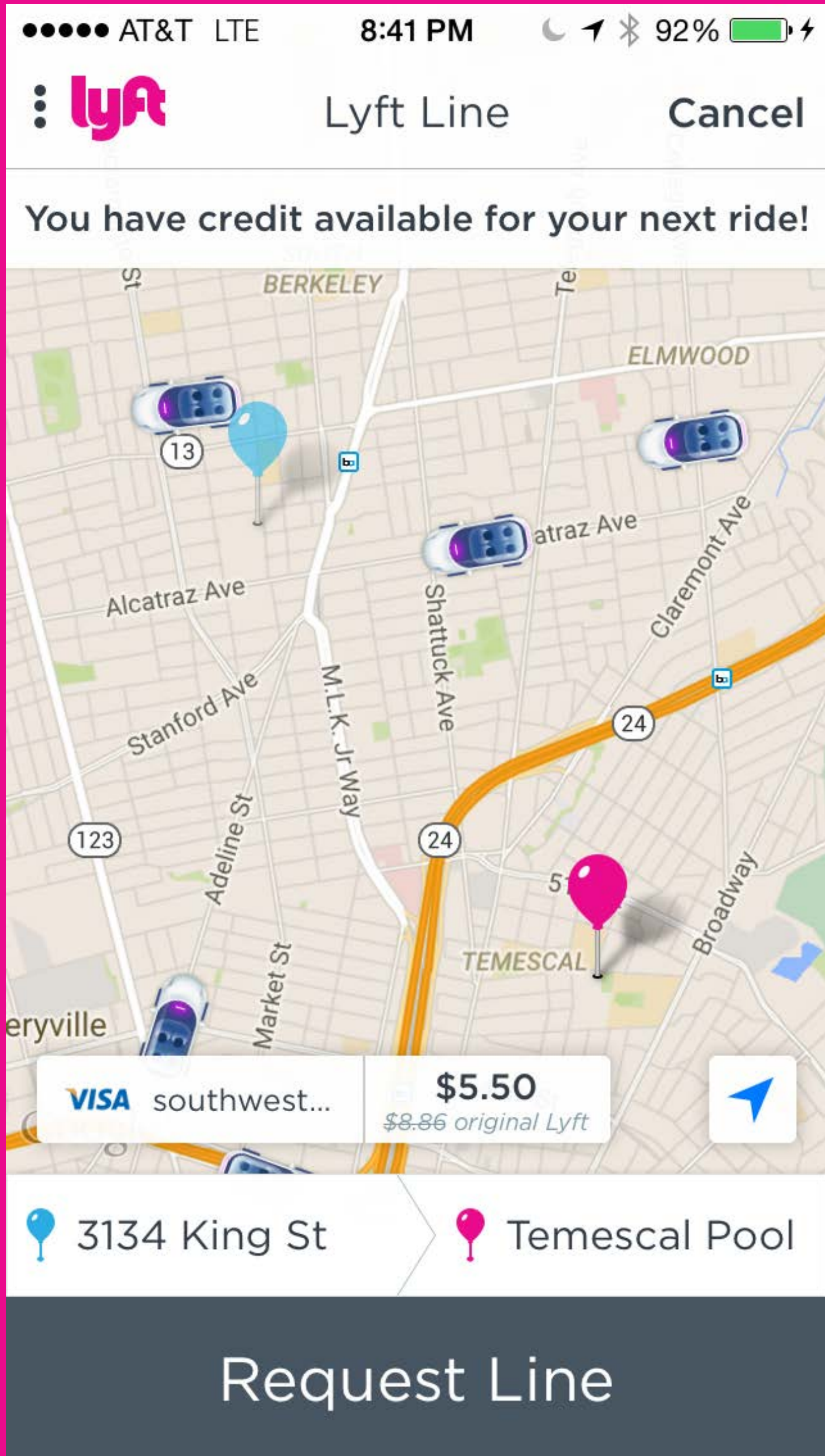
Lyft Plus
