Facies
-  Covered
 -  Crinoidal wackestone, very fine-grained, argillaceous.
 -  Crinoidal grainstone, fine- to coarse-grained, locally with green, siliciclastic, mudstone clasts
 -  Siliciclastic mudstone with local concentrations of dispersed crinoid grains.
