

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO REISSUE
HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT POST CLOSURE PERMIT
YKK (U.S.A.) INC.**

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) has tentatively decided to reissue a hazardous waste post closure permit to for the closed YKK (U.S.A.) Inc. Hazardous Waste Landfill (YKK). The YKK Landfill (Centerville, TN) (EPA ID TND069080513) is located at 200 Universal Drive, Centerville, Tennessee 37033. **TDEC invites the public to submit comments on this proposal during a 45-day comment period ending on August 29, 2024.**

The current permit, TNHW-151, was issued September 19, 2012, and was effective for 10 years. YKK's submitted an extension request on March 23, 2022, to the DSWM, to extend the submittal date of their Part A and Part B Hazardous Waste Post-Closure Permit Renewal Application. The DSWM approved of the extension for submittal of the application until May 31, 2022. YKK submitted the Part A and B application on March 31, 2022, allowing continued operations under the existing permit pending a final decision being made on the application. As part of the permitting process, YKK held a pre-application public meeting on May 26, 2022, as announced in the April 25, 2022, edition of Hickman County Times. No members of the public attended the meeting, and no oral or written comments were received.

YKK (U.S.A.) Inc., formerly Universal Fasteners Inc., and later as YKK Snap Fasteners of America Inc., was a metal fabricating company engaged in the manufacturing, painting, and plating of metal buttons, snap fasteners, and related items for the garment and other industries. The facility is located at 200 Universal Drive, Centerville, Hickman County, Tennessee 37033. The area is zoned Industrial II (heavy industrial/commercial). The land surrounding YKK is made up of both residential and government owned land. The facility's property is also bordered by the Duck River to the west and by the Indian Creek to the east. The facility's manufacturing and plating operations took place in a 117,000-sq.ft building. YKK ceased manufacturing operations at the facility on June 1, 2007. Tract 2 ownership is retained by YKK as an 11.85-acre tract that contains one unit; the RCRA Impoundment Area closed as a landfill with waste in place and is subject to the terms and conditions of this permit.

The proposed permit requires YKK to continue post-closure care, groundwater monitoring, maintenance of the closed landfill, and requires YKK to provide to the Division notification of imminent hazards, and when applicable, compliance with the requirements developed under the land disposal restrictions and organic air emission standards.

Based on the review of the renewal application and as authorized pursuant to Tennessee Rule 0400-12-01-.07(7), DSWM determined the application to be complete and has drafted a renewal permit. DSWM proposes to reissue the permit under the authority of the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1977, as amended, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101 et seq., and Rule Chapter 0400-12-01, Hazardous Waste Management. In accordance with Rule 0400-12-01-.07(7)(e), this notice requires a 45-day comment period, beginning on the date of this publication and the opportunity to request a public hearing. A fact sheet has been prepared that provides additional information about the site and the proposed permit. Pending consideration of any contrary information received, it is the present intent of DSWM to reissue this permit. If reissued, the permit would be effective for ten years.

Comments must be received by 4:30 p.m. CDT, August 29, 2024, to assure consideration.

A request for a public hearing shall be in writing and shall state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing.

After considering all comments, DSWM will make a final decision to either issue or deny the permit. Notice will be given to the applicant and each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice of the final decision. At the time a final decision is issued, a Response to Comments document addressing all significant input received on the draft permit will be made available to the public. The final decision shall become effective upon signing by the Director of DSWM.
