

**TRANSFER OF LANDFILL OWNERSHIP APPROVED  
FROM TRIUNE RESIDUALS MANAGEMENT, LLC TO WASTE CONNECTIONS OF  
TENNESSEE, INC.**

Waste Connections of Tennessee, Inc. has taken ownership of the Class IV landfill at 3530 Central Pike, Hermitage, TN 37076 (latitude 36.17795/longitude -86.63404). The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation's (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) approved a change of ownership for the Class IV landfill, pursuant to Rule 0400-11-01-.02(6)(a) of Tennessee's Solid Waste Program Processing and Disposal Regulations. Waste Connections of Tennessee, Inc. applied for a minor permit modification to transfer the permit for the Central Pike Class IV Landfill (DML190000090) from the previous owner, Triune Residuals Management, LLC. As part of this transfer of ownership, the facility name has changed from the Triune Residuals Management, LLC – Central Pike Class IV Landfill to the Waste Connections of TN – Central Pike Class IV Landfill. The operator has changed from Triune Residuals Management, LLC to Waste Connections of Tennessee, Inc. The final decision to issue the permit modification was made on Friday, May 31, 2024.
