	Activity:	Jordan Blevins proposes to install 476 feet of gabion baskets for erosion abatement and construct a concrete sidewalk/ramp that extends three feet below normal summer pool elevation on Boone Reservoir in Piney Flats (Sullivan County). Construction will be during winter pool elevation.

Dredged material will be placed in the bay to expand existing wetlands, filling approximately 0.5 acres of open water.

NRS23.104 **Applicant:** Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA)
Activity: The Tennessee Valley Authority proposes to fill 6.6 acres of Emory River backwater near its Kingston Fossil Plant (Roane County) in support of east containment dike seismic stabilization requirements. Fish habitat structures will be installed at 40 sites, primarily in Watts Bar, to offset habitat loss.
