

2010 Lobbyist Registration Audit of Charles Cagle

FINDINGS

Mr. Charles Cagle failed to timely register as a lobbyist for one employer (See Registrations section).

EMPLOYER

- TN Organization of School Superintendent
- Assn of Independent/ Municipal Schools
- Career Education Corporation
- Middle Tennessee School of Anesthesia

REGISTRATIONS

Mr. Cagle registered as a lobbyist for four employers during 2010. Based on the audit documentation, Mr. Cagle failed to timely register for one of his employers. The Middle Tennessee School of Anesthesia registered as an employer of the lobbyist on March 23, 2010. The employer registration was the earliest date determinable that a lobbying relationship occurred that required registration by the lobbyist. Therefore, Mr. Cagle had to register by March 30, 2010 to be within seven days required by statute. The lobbyist did not register until March 31, 2010, 1 day late.

LOBBYING AGREEMENTS

Based on a review of the documentation provided by Mr. Cagle, he had a written contract with four clients. The terms of each contract appear to be within the statutes for lobbying activities including having no terms for contingency payments based on lobbying success.

FAMILY OR BUSINESS ARRANGEMENTS WITH PUBLIC OFFICIALS

Mr. Cagle reported he had no business or familial relationships with persons who were officials in the legislative branch or officials in the executive branch.

TRAINING & FEES

Based on review of the Bureau of Ethics and Campaign Finance's lobbyist records, Mr. Cagle completed his required lobbyist training for the 2010 registration year and paid all registration fees.
