The project will include the following described construction:

The furnishing, installing, and testing of approximately 21,000 linear feet of 16" C-900 PVC Force Main and 700 linear feet of 16" Force Main by directional and jack bore methods. Testing, bypass wastewater pumping, unclassified excavation, backfill, tie-ins, working in close proximity with other utilities and structures, restoration, asphalt pavement repair and maintenance, and all other appurtenances and other work as shown on the Construction Drawings or indicated in the Contract Specifications.

Subject to the provisions of Chapter 6 of Title 62 of the Tennessee Codes Annotated, the Contractor's attention is directed to the Tennessee Codes Annotated Section 62-6-119 which states that it will be necessary for each bidder to show evidence of a license before his bid will be considered and that the license number, expiration date, and that part of the classification applying to the bid appear on the envelope containing the bid; otherwise the bid shall not be opened.
