Sealed Bids for the construction of the **NEW HOPE WATER MAIN ARP PROJECT (Phase 2, Section 1)** will be received by White House Utility District, at 3303 Highway 31-W, White House, Tennessee 37188, until **9:00 a.m.** local time on **September 6, 2024** at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud (via video conference).

The Project consists of installing 2,220 linear feet of new 24" ductile iron water main, various size main tie-ins, related valves, connections, fittings and ancillary equipment near Hendersonville, TN, Sumner County.
