Rule 0460-02-.07 Anesthesia And Sedation is amended by deleting subparts (6)(b)(6)(i), (6)(b)(6)(ii), (7)(b)(6)(i), (7)(b)(6)(ii), and (7)(b)(6)(iii) in their entirety and substituting instead the following language:

- (6) (b) (6) (i) Written protocols must be established by the dentist to manage emergencies related to conscious sedation including but not limited to laryngospasm, bronchospasm, emesis and aspiration, airway occlusion by foreign body, angina pectoris, myocardial infarction, hypertension, hypotension, allergic and toxic reactions, convulsions, hyperventilation and hypoventilation. Written protocols must be kept with the emergency equipment and drugs.
- (6) (b) (6) (ii) Training to familiarize the operating team with these protocols must be periodic and current. Regular staff education programs and training sessions shall be provided and documented which include sessions on emergencies, life saving measures, medical equipment, and utility systems.
- (7) (b) (6) (i) Written protocols must be established by the dentist to manage emergencies related to deep sedation/general anesthesia including but not limited to laryngospasm, bronchospasm, emesis and aspiration, airway occlusion by foreign body, angina pectoris, myocardial infarction, hypertension, hypotension, allergic and toxic reactions, convulsions, hyperventilation and hypoventilation. Written protocols must be kept with the emergency equipment and drugs.
- (7) (b) (6) (ii) If anesthetic agents implicated in the etiology of malignant hyperthermia are used, written protocols to treat the malignant hyperthermia must be established.
- (7) (b) (6) (iii) Training to familiarize the operating team with these protocols must be periodic and current. Regular staff education programs and training sessions shall be provided and documented which include sessions on emergencies, life saving measures, medical equipment, and utility systems.
