Tennessee Department of Health (TDH) onboarding process for public health reporting begins when a potential trading partner registers their intent to report using the Trading Partner Registration (TPR) system. TPR manages active engagement statuses, generates emails and letters as proof of public health reporting for registered users. TDH has declared readiness to support Promoting Interoperability (PI) Programs for the public health reporting options listed below:

- Cancer Case Reporting (eligible professionals only)
- Electronic Lab Reporting
- Immunization Registry Reporting
- Syndromic Surveillance Messaging (eligible hospital w/emergency department)
