TOPICS OF DISCUSSION

Focus: Responses of the Survey

Presenter: Elizabeth Hart & Dr. Tamara Chavez-Lindell, Sr. Epidemiologist of DHDE

Summary: Today's discussion was about the 2022 Survey of Priorities Report, which entails the (4) major disparities and they are chronic disease, infectious disease, mental health and environmental health and injustice. The survey was

emailed to nearly 1300 people but only 183 responded which shows in graph wise, that only 11% respondents completed the survey and 89% did not. The survey was grouped into (4) groups such as local and state, federal government, independent, community members and advocates and the chart is broken down in many different categories as well such as rural, urban, LGBTQ community, persons with disability and Medicaid and Medicare recipients, etc.

The survey represented a large variety of folks within the 95 counties but most of the coverage were from government employees. Half of those responded to the survey noted mental health and chronic disease were areas of their concern and the other half noted infectious disease and environmental injustice was a sense of concern for them. We certainly do appreciate the feedback of the survey because we seek to do this more, as time progress to receive your ideas, suggestions, and concerns and present as much as we can to state officials. During this task force meeting a small Community Group was created, to assist in creating a better system to categorize the data retrieved, this group will be led by Elizabeth Hart, Director of OFBCE and Dr. Tamara Chavez-Lindell, Sr. Epidemiologist with following participants noted below:
